

The former fire engine workshops of the London Fire Brigade, has opened its doors once again to provide an events space. The 2000sqm space, can house up to 70 traders.

The Workshop space is also home to an eclectic mix of creative tenants including; the Institute of Imagination, Kidesign, Vivid Drinks, Mark Lloyd Bennett Design and multi-disciplinary artists Christopher Baxter, Luke Francis Haseler and Barry Reigate.

The Workshop is also excited to announce that the London Fire Brigade has marked its 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary by returning to the original location of its former headquarters on Albert Embankment, with a pop up museum. Showcasing the history of fire-fighting through the story of The London Fire Brigade in Lambeth. The museum is FREE to visit and open Wednesdays- Sundays 10am-4pm

## Vauxhall past and present

Since the 18<sup>th</sup> century, when over 10 million revellers flocked to the famed attraction of the Vauxhall Pleasure gardens, Vauxhall has been a destination for Londoners. Today sees Vauxhall at the heart of an emerging Gallery District with the Pleasure Gardens still pulling in the crowds for a series of year-round events, from free open-air cinemas to the Royal Vauxhall Tavern's famous Gay Sports Day.

## Vauxhall Gallery District

A century ago Vauxhall was a leading arts-and-craft district, populated by glassblowers, potters and sculptors.

Today Vauxhall is becoming one of London's hottest new arts destinations.

The Vauxhall Gallery District currently consists of Damien Hirst's £25million, six-room, 37,000sq ft Newport Street Gallery, ex-'Ragged School' turned contemporary arts space Beaconsfield Gallery (also located on Newport Street), Gasworks Gallery which specialises in fostering budding international artist and Charles Asprey's soon-to-be opened Cabinet Gallery on Vauxhall Pleasure Gardens. All are within walking distance of each other.
