ATTRO – What does it mean?

After vehicle borne terror attacks have continued globally, the Metropolitan Police have advised the ATTRO (Anti-Terrorist Traffic Regulation Order) that was brought in around the ground last year to be made permanent, on major match days. What does this mean in practical terms?

- **Harleyford Road, between Oval tube station and Durham Street (The Beehive), will be closed to all traffic for two separate periods of up to two hours, around the arrival and departure of fans, on every day, as per the above list. There will also be closures on Vauxhall Street, Bowling Green Street and Clayton Street.**
- The roads will be completely closed to all traffic, including cyclists, for this period of time. The Club retains the right to make exceptions to this based on circumstance and each blockade will be operated by our specialist transport management team. If you have a specific personal circumstance, please get in touch with the club using the details on this newsletter.
- Buses will be redirected during this period, taking a different route to Vauxhall.
- The Club will continue to work with all affected residents and businesses, communicating directly with a wide range of local groups, stakeholders and elected representatives. If you have a specific query, please get in touch with the club directly using the details on this newsletter.
- At the time of going to press, the formal consultation on the permanence of this scheme is still ongoing.
- This arrangement will first be in situ on Friday May 22nd, between 5.30pm and 6.45pm and then again at the end of the Vitality Blast double header between Surrey and Lancashire.
- Please be aware that this arrangement is out of our control and has not been requested by the Club. We will seek to enact the ATTRO with full consideration for our local community and welcome feedback at all times. Lambeth Council Elections

Temporary traffic measures will be in place on Thursday 7 May 2026 to support Lambeth Council election operations.

- Restrictions will affect Clayton Street, Bowling Green Street, Kennington Oval and Vauxhall Street.
- Parking bays on Kennington Oval and Clayton Street will be suspended from 10am on 7 May until 1am on 8 May. Vehicles left in suspended bays may be relocated nearby.
- From 4pm to 1am, road closures will apply alongside a no waiting, loading or unloading restriction. Resident access will be managed by traffic marshals and escorted where needed.
- Visitors and delivery drivers should avoid the area after 8pm, as access cannot be guaranteed.
- Between 10pm and midnight, increased council vehicle activity is expected. Signage and marshals will be in place.
